Regarding origin of our family, Miss Sadie Rue (Sarah D. Rue #3faccd), now deceased, formerly of Belle Haven, Va. was the best informed member of the family concerning its history. She stated to the authors, that her grandfather William Rue remembered his grandfather Wonne Rue II very well, having been 16 years of age when Wonne II died, and remembered hearing Wonne say that the family was originally from France.

The name "Wonne" is most unusual and has not been traced to any country so far as can be learned. However, competent French language authorities believe that it is a derivative of the French name "Rene".

It seems reasonable to suppose that the family name may have been La Rue, and the pronunciation by the English colonial settlers of Virginia made it first "Arew" (A'rew) and later dropped the "A" altogether. The change from Rew to Rue, or visa versa, was natural, and the spelling "Rhue" may probably be laid at the door of the German settlers in and around Wilmington, N.C. This may also apply to the spelling "Ruhe" and "Rhew"; however these two have not been included in this work. The Rhue, Ruhe, Rhew spellings are not found in Virginia.

THE REW, RUE, RHUE FAMILY

THE REW, RUE, RHUE FAMILY

The story of our family for the past three hundred years, is the history of early America; emigration to Jamestown Colony, settlement on waterways, first in Accomac County on the "Eastern Shores" of Virginia, then gradual emigration south and west, always on "sounds" or rivers; great land holdings at first, with farming, seafaring and occasional office-holding as their way of life, - the prefixes to their names reading Captain, Esquire, Gentleman, Planter. Then came the downward swing in many of their fortunes, - particularly those of Carolina, - families wiped out by malaria, smallpox, the plague; land sold parcel by parcel, mortgaged and lost for a few pennies, taxes unpaid, until little or nothing was left of the ancestral plantations. In many places, the family name drops out of all records except those of marriage and these disappear as the westward urge takes the individuals in untraceable migration. The old gravestones in pine thickets on old farms have fallen over, their inscriptions obliterated, family bibles have disintegrated, and the Revolutionary and Civil war destruction of public records has created difficulties which will forever defeat any possibility of securing a complete record of the family. The data hereinafter shown has been gathered from existing state and county records, census reports, family bibles and from the marvelous memory of the last of a long line of family historians who passed down the history of their tribe by word of mouth from generation to generation. Nevertheless, despite intense search and study, the proof of every step in the lines of Thomas Arew, Sr. and Thomas Rue, Jr was not found, so in such cases, the relationship has been qualified as "possibly" or "probably", in this work.

Our surname has been variously spelled Arew, Arieu, Arue, Rew, Rue and Rhue; possibly also Rhew, altho the family using the latter spelling has not been touched upon in this record. The majority of the earliest records pertaining to our immigrant ancestor, listed his name as "JOHN AREW". His children and succeeding generations in Virginia spelled it REW, except for the descendants of William Rew II (1806-1891) who used the form RUE. The Hyde County, North Carolina line generally used the form RUE, while the Craven County, N.C. branch preferred REW, and the Carteret County, N.C. family which became the Wilmington, N.C. line also used all forms of the name indiscriminately as we too shall use the Rew or Rue spelling loosely in many parts of this work.

It is probable that the majority of all persons in the southern portion of the United States bearing the family name, in one of its various forms, have descended from the John Arew mentioned above. It has not yet been learned from what country John originally came. Some think he was Welsh, others believe he was French. There is a record in Hotten's "Original Lists of Persons of Quality who went from England to the American Colonies" of a Jan Le Rou, printer, wife and 6 children who came to Virginia in 1621. He is listed under the heading "Walloons and French". This could not have been our John Arew for Jan Le Rou's children must have been born at least between 1611 and 1621 and that would make them too old to have been the children of our John Arew whose dates of death we know. The first proven record regarding our John Arew was on November 9, 1666 when he was granted a patent for "Three Hundred acres of land, situated in Accomac County, at the south side of the southern branch of Hunting Creek, and bounded on the northeast therewith; on the northwest by the lands of James Atkinson; on the southeast by the lands

of Christopher Thompson; on the southwest by a right line; the land being due for the transportation of six persons into the colony of Virginia". (Book 6 page 20 of the Virginia Land Office). This grant indicates at least, that our John Arew married in the old country and that his children were born there, and that the six dependents - wife and five children - were brought by John Arew to the new world and he received, as was customary, 50 acres for the ship passage of each of them.

John Arew died testate in Accomac County, Va. in 1669. His will devised his land equally to his three sons, John, Thomas and Wonney. His two daughters were mentioned but not named. His wife Dorothy had predeceased him.

John Arew II died testate in Accomac County in 1814 leaving his wife Lesche (Elisheba) Ward Arew, daughter of Benoni and Sarah Ward of Accomac County, and children, Thomas and Catherine. This Thomas is probably the ancestor from whom the Hyde County, North Carolina branch descended.

Thomas Arew, one of the three sons of the first John, disappeared from Accomac County prior to 1735 and his nephew Thomas succeeded to his estate, showing that Thomas Arew, Sr. was not married or had no issue at that time. Either the uncle or the nephew Thomas Arew (Rew) was mentioned as "kinsman" in the will of George Ewell in 1728 in Accomac County but no address or further information about this "Kinsman" was given.

There is a family tradition in both the Virginia and the Carteret County, North Carolina line, concerning those three brothers who came to America, both stories agreeing that one of the brothers disappeared into the western wilderness (this undoubtedly was Thomas Arew, Sr.), one remained in Virginia (this, of course, was Wonney) and the third line came to North Carolina (without doubt, Thomas Arew, Jr. son of John Arew II)

Wonney was the one from whom the majority of the family descended. He was married twice, his first wife having been Comfort Gelding, daughter of Charles Gelding of Northampton County, Va. The will of Charles Gelding dated 1709, mentions his daughter Comfort Rew and grandson Southy Rew. This Southy Rew was the first of a long line of Southys coming on down in the family to the present day. It is believed that other issue of the marriage of Wonney and Comfort Gelding were George, Charles and Comfort. After their mother died and about the time their father remarried, Southy and Charles moved to North Carolina.

It was during the first marriage of Wonney that he was appointed in 1714, surveyor of "ye King's Road in ye room of John Arew". There is a road in Accomac County, near Parksley, yet known as the "Wonney Rew Road". Wonney succeeded to this position as surveyor, upon the death of his brother John, who had been appointed in June of 1703.

It is interesting to note among the old records of Accomac County, that apparently the Courts of that day had as much trouble getting jurors as they do today, for in November of 1699, John Arew was fined 350 lbs. of tobacco for contempt, for failure to appear as a jurymen.

In 1741 Wonney (sometimes spelled Wonne) Rew and his eldest son, Southy, were ordered to view and lay off an acre of land belonging to Mark Ewell on Hunting Back Creek for building a public water grist mill. The following year Southy was found guilty of trespass, assault and battery upon the person of William Andrews and fined 40 shillings and costs. About that time, Southy was Sheriff and Justice of the Peace of Accomac County but around 1747 he and his wife Mary Brotherton Rew and their children, pulled up stakes and moved to Craven County, North Carolina, across Pamlico Sound from Hyde County, where by now, there was a large settlement of his relatives.
