This Genealogy gives the Ancestors and all the Descendants, both male and female lines, of Robert Brown, who was born in Blandford, Mass., in 1768 and settled in Nelson, Madison County, New York with his wife Elizabeth Campbell. Both were of Scotch-Irish descent. The Descendants, over 600 in number include in addition to Browns, the names of Alton, Carpenter, Ingalls, Ford, Reynolds, Smith, Spaulding, Sturtevant, and many others,

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EXPLANATION OF NUMBERING AND ARRANGEMENT

For convenience and as a means of identification each descendant in this genealogy so far as possible has been given a number starting with Robert Brown who is number 1. Children have been numbered consecutively in order of birth and they appear in this same order throughout the book. Since in each life sketch, parents names are always given with their proper number in brackets it is possible to go forward or backward with ease from generation to generation. A star or asterisk (*) placed before the name of a child of a couple indicates that more information about this person will be found in its proper numerical order on some later page in the book. Robert Brown of whom this genealogy treats is number 1. His children have numbers 2 to 10, the third generation 11 to 39, the fourth generation 40 to 142, the fifth from 143 to 343, and the sixth 344 to 570. Places, dates and addresses have been given where ever known. The author wishes to thank those descendants who so kindly cooperated in sending the data that made this record possible. He has corresponded with nearly a hundred persons and has letters and written records to substanciate all the data published herewith regarding the descendants of Robert Brown. In many cases the same data has been received from widely different sources. To discover the identity of Robert Brown himself and trace his ancestors has required years of research but the satisfaction afforded in piecing together this puzzle, and the many friendships formed, have fully compensated the author for his effort. He trusts this record will be welcomed by descendants. All data has been carefully checked and rechecked against originals. The author had difficulty in making out some of the written records sent to him and will appreciate it if anyone discovering errors in spelling or data will notify him so corrections can be made in library copies.

I HISTORY OF THE FAMILY NAME "BROWN"

The origin of the surname "Brown" was English. At the period when the growth of the population demanded something more than a given name to distinguish one individual from another, there were many dark-complexioned persons who were known as "John le Brun", or "Wymore le Broune", and these words came to distinguish their children as well as themselves, though many of the children may have been blonds. Thus the name "Brown" means brown.

The name has many orthographic peculiarities. Browning was the son of Brown; Brownell was the mighty Brown; Brownlee the Brown who lived in a pasture; Brownlow, the Brown who lived on a hill. Various forms are: Boown, Bown, Braum, Brouun, Browne, Borwnn, Brune, Brune, Brownson, Bronson, Broune, Brunnell and Burnett.

The name Brown is of frequent occurrance in

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early New England records. One hundred and twentyseven Browns emigrated to America before 1700. Over thirteen hundred, a regiment by themselves, served in the Revolution from Massachusetts alone. According to the Herald's College, England, the Browns have been granted one hundred fifty-six coats-of-arms. The name has been borne in the United States by men of mark in law, politics, business and letters.

DESCENDANTS OF WILLIAM BROWN OF BLANDFORD MASS



The above outline was prepared 1935 by Leon R Brown after a study of all available data including original town records, histories, deeds, wills, etc. as well as traditions and data that was handed down in different branches of the family. After having visited the cemetaries and the sites of the old Brown homesteads in Blandford the compiler believes that all the Browns in Blandford before 1800 were of the same family and has arranged the above as the probable setup although there is as yet no positive proof that any except William and Soloman were children of William Brown the imigrant. Naomi Parish in 1903 when "very old" said that her father's name was Israel Canfield Brown. She remembered her uncles and aunts correctly but said her grandfather's name was William. This is contrary to other records and it is thought she referred to her great grandfather. Some of James' record is taken from her letters and the remainder from the Twinsburg Ohio Centenial records. Items with a (*) are from the Blandford town records. (**) see Cannon Genealogy for descendants of these. The children of Roswell Brown were Harriet Anderson, Henrietta Adams, Isadore Richards and James. The children of James Brown born 1806 and his wife Emeline Waterman were Cornelia Riley, Betsey 1840-1841, Almon J born 1846 of Twinsburg, 0. (has a son James H born 1877), and Carlton 1855-1856.

ANCESTRY OF ROBERT BROWN

WILLIAM BROWN, the immigrant ancestor of Robert Brown, was of Scotch Trish descent and came from Ulster in the north of Ireland to Boston and then emigrated westward to New Glasgow, now Blandford, This was during the Scotch Irish immigration that began Mass. in 1719. Blandford is located in Hampton Co., then a part of Hampshire Co., on a high ridge overlooking a tributary of the Connecticut River. Nearly all the settlers of Blandford were from Ulster. The Irish records show many families of Brown's of Scotch ancestry who came to America. Among these was that of Mathew Brown who had sons Thomas, William, Robert and James. They settled in Palmer, Mass. near Blandford. The similarity of names indicates relationship. In 1739 William purchased Lots 19 and 25 East. He was described as "living on the land called the Gore lying between Worcester and Oxford in the County of Worcester". In the year 1762 William sold one of these lots to his son Soloman. This was lot 19 containing 60 acres, "with all the building and Housing Standing on the Same", for the sum of four hundred pounds, Soloman to "make such provision for the Said William Brown and his wife Martha Brown as shall be good and Comfortable for their Subsistance both in times of health and sickness viz. one Room in the House and so much of the Cellar as he or she shall have need of, also to keep two cows and one horse, Somers and Winters, also thirty bushels of grain, also 180 pounds of Beef, and also one third of the Cyder and Apples the said land produces and such necessary Sauces as ye land produces, all of which if said grantee faithfully perform toward ye Grantor and his wife then this present deed & Sufficiency of firewood also drawn to the door, to remain in full force and virtue, otherwise to be null and Void & of None Effect". Dec 10 1762 Signed William Brown His X mark & Seal". If he was illiterate, he was not unthrifty nor uncalculating, albeit he came near forgetting the wood. On Jan 11 1760 William Brown was listed on the town records as a pew holder and legal voter. William appears to have been the only Brown in Blandford about this time and there is little doubt that the following were his children:

WILLIAM BROWN JR. son of William Brown above was born in Blandford about 1740. In 1759 which was probably the year he married, William purchased from William Fisher Lots 24 and 10 East in the Home Tract. This land afterwards passed to his son William and was known as the Brown Farm or Homestead. Speaking of this farm Sumner Gilbert Wood in his book "Ulster Scots and Blandford Scouts" says "A little old house, on this lot as I suppose, on the northly side of the stage road running slantwise through these lots, was familiarly known as 'the Brown Sisters'. It gives, or gave, every appearance of great age.--- It is a little single-story house; plain front door between two windows. Many times have I visited it with fascinated interest, its fireplaces and cupboards all tumbling to ruin, silently eloquent of a sealed past. Zadock was apparently the last of the Browns here and he sold to Soloman Noble Jr. in 1810". William Brown Jr. fought in the war against the French and Indians in 1757 when many other Blandford men including his brother Soloman took up arms to protect Blandford against the Indians. The above mentioned book tells of this war service. It is probable that William Brown fought in the Revolution. His brother Soloman was Commissioned 2nd Lieut. and on May 31 1779 was Commissioned Captain of a Company of the Hampshire County Militia. A William Brown from Blandford served in Capt. Daniel Caldwell's Company, Col. Timothy Robinson's Regt. He enlisted Dec. 25 1776 and was discharged Feb. 13 1777 and saw service at Ticonderoga. He also enlisted in Capt. David Sackets Company, Col. Ruggles Woodbridge' Regt. on Aug 20 1777 and was discharged on Nov. 29 1777. He saw service "at the northward". Both William and Soloman had sons William born in 1760 and so only 16 years old in 1776. These were probably the only William Browns in Blandford other than William the subject of this paragraph. According to the birth The Town Clerk's records William's wife's name was Martha. records show the following children born to them:

ADDITIONAL FACTS ABOUT WILLIAM BROWN SR. (See page 3)

William Brown, grandfather of Robert, was born in Ireland 1702. He was a manufacturer of linen in Londonderry. He or his father moved there from Scotland. At least two of his children, including his son William, were born in Colerain, Ireland. His wife was Martha Miller and they came to America before 1735. In the party were Robert King and Andrew McLucas. They came to America to avoid religious persecution. William and others who came with him settled first at Hopkinton, Mass. They came to Blandford, Mass. in the fall of 1735. With their families they slept on the ground under their carts for a week until they could build log houses.

In speaking of the 60 acre lot (#19) occupied by William Brown in 1739 and sold to his son Soloman in 1762, Sumner Wood in his "Blandford Taverns" says: "The lot midway between (Almy and James Beard) and across the street known as the Brown Lot passed from Soloman and William Brown to Elisha Parks in 1769. This deed was signed also by William's wife Martha and Soloman's wife Jane. The lot had on it a dwelling house and barn probably a humbler abode than the competitor of the two taverns. It was sold to Samuel Bois in 1789". A modern looking house stands on the lot today. William Brown was frequently mentioned in the town clerk's records when the church and town records were one. One record dated Sept. 29,1747 reads: "Granted to William Brown 5 pounds 15 shillings for those things he provided for the ordination". On May 10,1754 William and his wife Martha deeded to his son William Jr. lot 24 in the first division of 60 acres.

ADDITIONAL FACTS ABOUT WILLIAM BROWN JR. (See page 3)

William Brown Jr., father of Robert Brown, was born in Colerain Ireland on Apr. 8,1731 and died in Blandford Apr. 13, 1808. He and his father, William, are said to be buried in the old cemetery north of Blandford near the town line of Chester where his son William is also buried. The author has visited and photographed this lonely and overgrown cemetery. The grave of William 3rd has a headstone and there are several graves marked only by large field stones. The cemetery is not far from the old Brown farm on the west end of old farm lot 20.

William Brown married in Pelham Dec. 1,1757, Nancy, daughter of Robert King of Pelham. According to old deeds Robert King at one time lived in Blandford. Where the birth of William's children appears in the town clerk's records the mother's name is given as Martha, but as these records are all on one page they appear to have been copied from a family Bible and it is probable that a mistake was made in the mother's name. In 1810 Nancy (Agnes in the church records), when she was over 80 years old, moved with her son Zadock and family to Wrightsburg now Saybrook, Ohio, then a wilderness. the first family to settle in the town. She died Jan. 3,1828 at the age of 99 years and 9 months and was the 2nd person to be buried in that town.

In his book "Old Taverns of Blandford", Sumner Wood gives the following record: "Fort George, Dec. 16,1775. Received of Henry Knox \$20 which Capt. John Johnson paid to different carters for the use of their cattle in dragging canon from Fort Ticondaroga to the North landing of Lake George, 10 pounds 8 shillings. (signed) Wm. Brown Jr. Lieut". This is thought to be the above William Brown as Gen. Knox was also from Blandford. When the turnpike was laid out leading northwest from the Main road across lot 24 and farm lot 20, William Brown, Levi Bois, James Beard and others whose land the new road crossed were awarded damages. As shown on the town records, William Brown received five dollars. Another record dated Dec. 3,1766 reads "Granted to William Brown one shilling, six pense for hors to Westfield (9 miles) to carry Fradrack Murphy". This was apparently a deportation from the town common in those days.

William Brown's son, William, married Hannah Lucas instead of Margaret Hais as previously given on page 4. Martha m. Daniel Lucas. Jean m. William Lucas. Thomas was probably a son of James a brother of William. Eleanor m. Isaac Coolidge who accompanied Robert to Cazenovia, N.Y. and then moved on to Ohio. Zadock m. Cynthia Mitchell. Elizabeth was probably not a daughter of William but of James.

ADDITIONAL FACTS ABOUT THE CHILDREN OF ROBERT BROWN (See page 6)

Nancy Brown (4) daughter of Robert (See page 6) m. Willard Morey and was in Nelson N.Y. in 1850. Her children were Henry J. b. 1834 and Lovader (1831-1903). Henry J. Morey had two daughters, one m. John Roseboom and the other m. Wm. Corbin. Betsy (7) m. Mowry Bennett of Fenner. He sold his land in 1830 and was not there in 1850. Jane (10) m. Mathias Hollenbeck 1st settler of Georgetown, Madison Co. N.Y. Pardon Hollenbeck 32 in the 1850 census of Fenner with wife Maria 23, and Polly Ann 4, Celia 3 and Elizabeth 1 and Lauren Hollenbeck 24 with wife Zerna 28, Aurilla 4 and Mary 1,were probably his sons. Robert Brown and his wife according to family tradition were buried in Black River, Jefferson Co. N.Y.

NOTE: The above data was obtained to a large extent from Dr. H. Gibbs of Boston, who obtained it from "Eleanor" Freeman of Seattle.

III ROBERT BROWN

 ROBERT BROWN was the son of William Brown Jr. and his wife Martha. He was born in Blandford, Hampshire Co. Mass. on Jan. 16 1768. The marriage banns of Robert and Elizabeth Campbell "of Southwick", Mass. were published April 13 1794. Their oldest son Quartis was born in 1795 and shortly thereafter and before 1800 they moved with other settlers to Nelson, then in Cazenovia Twp. Madison Co. N.Y.

Elizabeth was without doubt the daughter of Samuel Campbell of Southwick and was born according to the Robert Campbell Genealogy on Feb. 19 1770. This date corresponds to that of the wife of Robert as given in the Censuses from 1800 to 1840. No other Campbell has been found with a daughter Elizabeth of the right age to have been Robert's wife. Samuel Campbell, born Jan.8th 1736/7, married Apr. 10 1760 Esther Smith, was the son of James Campbell of Killingly,Conn. b.1704, d. 1773, and his wife Hannah Taylor. James Campbell was a son of Robert Campbell and came with his father from Tyronne, Ulster, in Ireland to New London in 1719. They were among the very first settlers of Voluntown, Connecticut.

Robert Brown and his family with his brother Soloman and his family, probably accompanied by the family of Isaac Coolidge, emigrated to Nelson before 1800. They are mentioned in the histories of Madison Co. among the first settlers of Nelson. In 1790 a Robert Brown was living near William Brown Jr. in Blandford Mass. Isaac Coolidge was a neighbor. In the 1800 census Robert Brown, Soloman Brown and Isaac Coolidge were located near each other in Cazenovia, N.Y. (Nelson Twp. was taken from Cazenovia). At this time the census lists Robert's family as consisting of two boys and a girl under 10, and Robert and his wife as being over 26 years of age.

On June 3 1808 according to a deed in the county clerks office Robert Purchased from William Covell, 75 acres of land now in Nelson township and being a part of Lot 10 and located near the town line about a mile north of Nelson Flatts. The census in 1810 shows him living next to William Covell and with three boys and a girl having been boen since 1800. In 1816 Robert purchased land from a man named Ferry. It was located in Smithfield now Fenner. This was apparently near his other farm and just over the town line. He must have moved to his new farm because the 1820 census shows him living in Smithfield. In the family at this time were two boys and two girls under 10, one boy between 10 and 16, and one between 18 and 26. There were two girls between 16 and 26. In 1821 Robert and his wife Betty sold the east half of Lot 55 in Smithfield (now Fenner) to his son Quartis for the sum of \$340. Fenner was taken from Smithfield about 1825 and the 1830 census shows Robert in Fenner between Taylor and Hyatt. He was between 60 and 70 years old and Betty was between 50 and 60. With them was a son and daughter between 15 and 20. Quartis in 1823 bought land "standing on the east side of the highway leading from Smithfield by Robert Brown's and Frasier Cutler's to the Turnpike".

In 1831 Robert bought land from his son William but sold it again the same day. In 1840 according to the census he was living in Cazenovia with his wife. At that time he was over 70 and she was under 70. There is no further record of him and it is certain that he died before 1850. He may be buried in the old cemetary near his old home in Fenner about two miles north of Nelson Flats where many of the old settlers are buried. It is said that his wife Elizabeth lived with her son George until she died about 1860, but she is not listed with his family in the 1855 census of Jefferson Co. N.Y. The following Children of Robert Brown are given in a published biography of Delos Brown now in the posession of Miss Christine Atwell of Cazenovia, N.Y.:

IV DESCENDANTS OF ROBERT BROWN, SECOND GENERATION

- 2. QUARTIS BROWN, son of Robert Brown, was born in Mass. (probably Blandford) in 1795. He moved with his parents to Fenner, then Cazenovia, in Madison Co. N.Y. He enlisted at Oswego and fought in the War of 1812 as a private in Capt. Stephen Dodge's Co. of New York State Militia from May 18 1812 to May 18 1813 and in Capt. Needham's Co. from Sept. 9 1814 to Nov. 13 1814. For this service he was granted a pension April 14 1871 on his Survivor Certificate No. 11574 when he was 76 years of age. He married at Nelson, Madison Co. N.Y. Nov. 10 1820 Julis Gibbs. On Feb. 9 1821 Quartis purchased from his father Robert Brown "the east half of Lot 55 in the 3rd allotment of the New Petersburgh Subdivision of Oneida Reservation". On March 18 1823 he purchased from Frasier Cutler for \$240 part of Lot 10 in Nelson "Standing on the east side of the highway leading from Smithfield by Robert Brown's and Frasier Cutler's to the Turnpike". These two parcels were near each other and about a mile north of Nelson Flatts. In 1823 Quartis sold both these parcels to his brother William. On the deed both Quartis and William are "of Smithfield". In the 1850 census Quartis was living in the town of Antwerp, Jefferson Co. where his age is given as 56 and that of his wife Julia as 53. She was born in N.Y. Their son John was then 14 years old. The author has talked with old residents of Jefferson Co. who knew Quartis Brown. He had two sets of teeth in both the upper and lower jaws. He is said to have been the toughest man in the county. The story is told that he could bite a nail in two. Quartis died in 1878 at the home of his son Henry in Philadelphia, N.Y. * 11. Achsah b. - 3. WILLIAM BROWN, son of Robert Brown was born May 13 1797. He may have fought in the war of 1812. At any rate he left his home in Madison Co. at an early age and went to Jefferson Co. N.Y. where he married July 2 1820, Robecca daughter of David Howland

b. Nov. 18 1835 m. Anna S Wright.

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and his wife Sarah Woodworth. David Howland was a Quaker Preacher who had organized a Society of Friends at Le Raysville in Jefferson Co. He was the son of Stephen Howland a descendant of Henry Howland who is said to be a brother of John Howland of Mayflower fame. Sarah Woodworth was the daughter of Selah Woodworth of Mayfield Fulton Co. N.Y. Selah fought in the Revolutionary War. Sarah was the mother of 14 children by David Howland and 5 by Barbour her 2nd husband who had had 5 children by his first wife. About 1823 William and his wife removed to Madison Co. N.Y. where he bought land from his brother Quartis in Smithfield. (now Fenner) He paid \$600 for this land. It is said that at one time William and three of his brothers worked in a saw mill in Cazenovia. On Dec. 20 1831 William and Rebecca sold their farm to Robert Brown William's father. About this time William left his family and went some say to Ohio and others to Penn. His grandson Augustus told the author that he saw two of his sons by another marriage in the Civil War. Another descendant says he built a saw mill near Cleveland. The records show a William Brown of Norwalk Ohio who died Jan. 1 1852 and was buried in the Erie St. Cemetary in Cleveland.

Rebecca married second in 1836 Levi Hubbard a preacher of Constableville, N.Y. Her daughter Adelaide by Levi Hubbard married a Burdick and Adelaid's grandson Henry Burdick of Gloversville, N.Y. has her wedding certificate with Rebecca's signature. Selah Woodworth, son of Caleb Woodworth, (See Woodworth Genealogy) was born in Connecticut, August 1750 and married December 30, 1773 at Salisbury Conn., Rebecca, daughter of Jacob Dunham. He with his brother Solomon and his wife's family were among the first settlers of Mayfield, Fulton Co., N.Y. In the Revolutionary War Selah was a Sergeant in the Tryon County Militia of the State of New York, Captain Little's Co., Col. Fisher's Regiment (See N.Y. in the Revolution.) He was Supervisor of Mayfield for many years and prominent in the early history of the town. His wife was of royal descent. (See Dunham Genealogy.) His Daughter

All descendants of John Wood Brown can justly claim descent from a Revolutionary soldier.
