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WILLIAM BROMWELL = MARY

Planter, of "Bromwell" Calvert Co. Will 4 Dec. 1660. [Credited to Kent Co. by Baldwin, prob. an error in copying] The name is spelled in various records "Bromel," "Bromhall," "Brummale," etc. He came from Eng. 1651 with wife, 2 sons, 5 servants; [had anoth. serv't who left Eng. in the "Mary and Francis," ca. Oct. 1655, and arriv. in the Province foll. Jan.] He enters rights to land 20 Nov. 1657 and recd. patent for "Bromwell" (so spelled) on 20 Nov. 1658. (500 acres, running N.N.E. up the N. side of Hunting Creek, a tributary of Patuxent River, surveyed 22 July 1656, and re-surveyed for Richard, son and heir, in 1674.)

In his will he appoints his "well beloved neighbors, and true and trusty friends," Wm. Parrott and Wm. Turner, overseers, but the latter appears to have robbed the chil. of their estate,

Came from Eng. 1651 with fath. by whose will he inher. a third of est. He owns all the land in Apr. 1676, when he dies, over full age, and his guardian gets all by marrying the "loving wife" on 8 May 1676, [H. W.R.C 1, deed 743, Land Rec. Annap.]

Exr. and sole beaif. of husb- in Apr. 1676.
"Gentleman," of Calvert Co. who m. the widow a few days after dec. of Rich'd, who had petitioned Court to compel him to disgorge estate.
[The plantation, "Bromell" was sold by this pair in 1679-84.]

Charles Brummale
beq. by father's will 1660 of a third of estate, but his name does not further appear.



ROBERT BRUMMELL

Planter, d. 1709; will Jan. 25; may be orig. from Eng., as the name appears in list of pass. on the "Hupp Mary" from Liverpool 1679. Plantations "Partnership" and "Taylor's Promise." He bought 400 acres in 1694.

REBECCA

Exr. of will of husb. 1709. One of this name d. 1720 Talb. Co. leaving lands in Dorch. Co. "Guthrie's Choice;" mentions 4 chil.: Abr., Jacob, Rebecca, and Mary Andrew, and gr. dau. Anna Andrew.



JACOB BROMWELL

Planter, Talbot Co.; name first appears in records as surety for admr. of John Paul est. 1723, and later for Wm. Bennet's admr. 1737. In 1739 buys lots in Oxf. of Wm. Coombes, and the lot next this of David Robinson in 1742; after litigation acquires "Ander-ton" of Henry Lowe, sells "Poplar Hill" and "Turbut's Field," and buys "Cove Hall" and "Fort Venture" in 1743-52 of Jno. Bennet. In 1750 his name is in list as "Annual Benefactor" of the Charity School, Oxf. with 25 others of Talb. Co.; this sch. was the forerunner of an Academy. In 1755 he buys "Wintersell," 200 ac- res, of Henry Lowe, which made litigation for almost a century for the desc'nts. (W. side Island Creek.) In same year he buys the Chapel ground, Oxf. of Vincent Lowe.

He d. 1757; will 15 Sep. (li. 30 B T. no. 2, pp. 412-13-14, Land Rec. Off. Annapolis,) John Sherwood III and Robert Bromwell sureties in sum 3,000 pounds sterling, (Test. Proc. Md. 36 p. 443.)

= MARY *Spedden*

Legacy from husb. 1757 of negro servants "Sambo," "Debb" and "Lucy." She frees "Deborah" in 1752, Talbot Co., and in 1785, then a resident of Dorch. Co. deeds negroes "Rachel" and "Peter" to her son John, who, in 1790 gives them to his brother Edward: in this year she frees "Levin" and "David;" in 1794 she lives in Talb. Co., and makes deed of gift of negroes "Jim," and "Lucy" to her "loving grand daughter Spicie Bromwell." (dau. of Sped- ding Bromwell.)



Prob. eld. son; takes poss. of 'Cove Hall' and Fort Venture' in 1769 on a decision of Court against Nic. Thomas but sells to Jas. Colson. d 1771 (estate adm. by wid.) leaves slaves Sam, Hagar, Atha. Amy, and Phillis.

MARY SHERWOOD

b. 15 Aug. 1729 dau. Edw. Mann Sherwood. (see next chart for her fath. fam.) files adm. bond husb. estate 1771, her will 14 June 1784, prob. Aug 16 1784, Edw. Bromwell and David Robinson sur.

Mariner and planter (2d son) b. 3 Oct. 1731 d. ca. 1765. fam. trad. rec. that he was a Gov't pilot in Chesapeake Bay, was drowned, and body aft. ident. by his gold cuff buttons. One of the name was. Capt. of the 'Humming Bird' 1756 Talb. Co. He inherits from fath. lands 'Anderton' and 'Wintersell,' also negro servants 'Dibb' and 'Sam.'

adm. husb. est. 1769, when she pays taxes on 'Anderton' and 'Wintersell.' (One of the name has deed in 1767 of tract of land 'Maulden' on Cooke's Point Dorch. Co., from Edw. Spedden.) She prob. remar. to a Sherwood as she bears this name in 1788 when she joins son Jacob in deed to pt. of 'Wintersell'

His guar. dur. minority was Wm. Bromwell, prob. his uncle. In 1785 deeds to broth. Jer. "in consideration of the love he bears him," lots in Oxford, S. of Market Sq. etc. He was one of the founders of Methodiam in Oxf.; frees slaves; mem. Talb. Militia 1781. He had much litigation over lands.





In 1779 buys lots 13-14 in Oxf. near the Market Place, of the Marklands; in 1783 buys back of James Benson the lot next Chapel yard; also the windmill; in 1792 lot 50 in Oxf. of Jno. Fairbanks; also owned lots 38-39-40-41-59-60-61-90, and places "Lowe's Ramble" and "Bromwell's Discovery," and one called "Bromwell's Adventure" near "Plinlimmon," prob. named after the one in Dorch. Co. He had exp'va. litig. wth prop. seems to have d. near 1816, tho' there is confus. of ident. the name appears in land and oth. rec. with husb. has sisters Mary and Margaret. (Markland. ?)

Charles M.
 Prob. son of Edw. above; living in 1884. had "Oldham's Discovery;" one of this name m. Pamela F. McGinny. Talb. Co. 13 Nov. 1821; his widow seems to be Mary C., who relinq. rights of dower, in 1849; she owned lots 71-72 in Oxf., her home on lot 72. In 1822 Chas. M. B. owned Oxf. lots 38-39-40-41-59-60, and windmill.



Scrivener: will 24 Sep. and 24 Dec. 1770. Pub. records show that he had lands "Add. to Friendship," 26 acres, a part of "Benjamin's Goodwill," 96 acres, pt of "Flag Meadows," 230 acres, and "Poor Scrivener's Folly" 600 acres. (Patent p. 442, li. B C & G L no. 27) No inf. rel. to his parentage.

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SUSANNA FORTT

m. 7 Mar. 1750. (Rec. St Thomas, Episcopal Ch. Balt.) Widow. 1770; has legacy from husb. of negroes "Ruth" and "Jacob." 'to wait on her.'



He had other lands, 'Lane's Delight,' 83 acres, 'Green's Goodwill,' 66 acres, 'Williams' Re-survey,' 92 acres, lot 159 Barnet Alley; also 'Diggs' Discovery,' 'Bucks' Park,' 'Hail's Adventure,' 54 acres, and 'Elizabeth's Fancy.' In 1810 one of this name dwelt in 'Soldier's Delight Hund,' was a magistrate for Balt. City 1819, and in 1820 contrib. to bldg. of St John's Episc. Ch. had 10 in fam. and 20 slaves.

Eng. in 1678 to St Marie's Co.; he and John Hungerford each having grant of 50 acres of land which they transferred to Jno. Pollard of Dorch. Co.; if not same this may be fath. of Thomas above.

Thomas Bramhall binds also with his own son Wm. his "son in law" James Dawson, æ 9 yrs 16 Nov. 1712. "unto Richd Estes, he obliging himself to take the same care to interest him to read as of his own children." (p. 190 liber E no. 3, Court Rec. Port Tobacco, Chas. Co.)
